# LOPH LIVE

Our focus at Heritage for 2011 is Love God and Pursue Holiness. A major part of this emphasis is a series of Monday night revival services at 6:30pm on August 15, 22 and 29 called LGPH Live. As we prepare for these special encounters with God reflect on these passages of scripture:

- Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. Deuteronomy 6:5
- Sow for yourselves righteousness, reap the fruit of unfailing love, and break up your unplowed ground; for it is time to seek the LORD, until he comes and showers righteousness on you. Hosea 10:12
- If My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray, and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

Pray for personal revival in your own life. Remember the church can experience revival, but if you do not seek God with all of your heart, you will miss it. Read and pray through *Returning to Holiness* again. Confess your sin to God and celebrate His forgiveness. Ask those you have wronged for forgiveness and seek to make restitution when needed. Ask God to speak to you and change you during these special worship encounters.

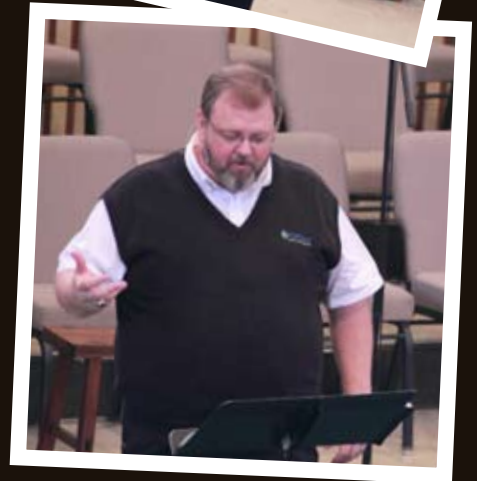
Pray for others to experience revival. Pray for your family and friends that this will be a time of renewal and revival in their lives. Pray for those who need to be encouraged or those who are struggling with their walk with God that this will be a season of restoration in their lives. Look for opportunities to invite them to the LGPH Live services and encourage them in their walk.

Pray for the lost. Pray that during these services they will experience a life changing relationship with Jesus Christ. Look for opportunities to share your testimony of God's work in your life with them. Invite them to be your guest at the LGPH services. Look for ways to show them God's love and share the gospel of Christ with them.

- Corporate Prayer for Revival on Sunday night July 17. Join us in the sanctuary at 5pm for an evening of prayer and praise as we seek God and ask Him to send revival to our hearts.

- Community Prayer Walk on Sunday July 31. Join us as we prayer walk our community and pass out invitations to each home for our LGPH Live services.

Joshua pronounces one of the most poignant declarations of faith when he proclaims to the people of Israel, "As for me and my family, we'll worship God." This spring, Heritage was given a picture of this life changing faith when Chris and Amanda Hagen were baptized and dedicated their two girls on the same day.

In 2004, Chris and Amanda lost their son Aaron to a birth defect. As they embraced their loss, the Hagens looked for ways to help other families. They met Kim Wilson and began volunteering with the Footprints Ministry, serving families with babies in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. Kim invited the Hagens to Sunday school at Heritage. Amanda remembers, "We really enjoyed the class and felt comfortable going there and meeting new people. God continued to lead us back to Heritage each week."

Along with their little girls, Emerson and Cameron, the Hagens began learning more about God and His desire to have a love relationship with them. Although Chris grew up around church, he felt like he never really connected. God continued to draw the Hagens into a relationship with him, and they began to think about baptism and church membership. They prayed together about this

big decision. On April 10, Chris and Amanda were baptized. According to Chris, "it was very special to be able to do that together."

Not only did Chris and Amanda publicly declare their decision to follow God through baptism, they also demonstrated their desire to worship God as a family through Parent Child Dedication. The Hagens attended the Heritage LifeStones Parent Seminar in preparation for this special day. Amanda said, "We learned that LifeStones is the stepping stone for Chris and me to lead the girls to grow in their relationship with Christ." The LifeStones seminars have given the Hagens "more confidence and a good start on leading the girls." Chris and Amanda are growing in their relationships with Christ as they are teaching and guiding their children.

Through Sunday School and LifeStones, the Hagens began a life changing relationship with Jesus Christ. Chris says, "I can only hope that more people will join the church and can experience the joy that we have since we have been attending." Amanda agrees, "We are all learning and growing together with Heritage supporting us all the way."
